



CONTESTANT RULES

- 1 You must be 16 years of age or older to apply.
- 2 You must live along the Coulee Corridor National Scenic Byway. See corridor map on www.couleecorridor.com for eligible locations.
- 3 You must be an amateur vocalist. (That means no recording contracts on your resume!)
- 4 You must be available to perform on Saturday, March 5, 2011 for the Byway Idol-Big Event in Soap Lake. If selected, applicants will also be selected to perform live in front of the Byway Idol Panel in January or February.
- 5 Application will not be returned and the Coulee Corridor Consortium has the right to use any information/images provided in the application to promote the Byway Idol and/or the Coulee Corridor National Scenic Byway.
- 6 If you are a finalist, you will be required to make a 3-5 minute video of yourself along the byway. This video will be used at the Byway Idol event in a video presentation.

SONG CRITERIA

- 1 Songs must be 4 minutes or less.
- 2 Contestant is not limited to any particular style of music. Be creative and just sing your heart out!
- 3 No live props can be used. You may use your own musical instrument.
- 4 No vulgar or explicit lyrics. Appropriate dress is also required.
- 5 Contestants will be judged by a panel that consists of Coulee Corridor Consortium members.

SCORING BREAKDOWN

150 points total

50- Vocal Ability (rhyme, pitch phrasing)

50- Stage Presence/Appeal (movement, confidence, command)

50- Application/Essay

The Byway Idol Panel will contact contestants who will be asked to perform live in February. Contestants will be required to bring their own music/instrument. Details about the live performance will be sent out to contestants and posted on the web site in February.
